SCRIPTURE-BASED PRAYERS

Prepare to Pray the A.C.T.S. way: Adoration, Confession, Thanksgiving and Supplication

Use these Scripture-based prayer to prepare yourself to intercede.

I. Adoration and Worship: Establish God's Sovereignty and Supremacy

O Lord, You reign over the nations and You rule in righteousness from Your holy throne.

—Psalm 47:8

I praise you for the trustworthiness and truth of Your word and Your person, O God. You are faithful and holy and righteous in all Your ways.

O Lord, You are great and mighty and majestic in Your power and authority! You see and know all things and there is no limit to Your understanding—it is beyond my comprehension.

II. Confession: Agreeing with God About My Sin

O God, I acknowledge that I am a sinner. It is useless to try to hide my sin, because nothing is hidden

from Your eyes. I confess my sins to you, thanking you for removing my guilt with Your forgiveness.
